- Customer to dig trench 3' deep between PUD installed secondary pedestal/moped and meter base, for additional please see the Residential Service Workbook; <u>Microsoft Word - 2023 RESIDENTIAL</u> <u>Blue Workbook\_Final.docx (grantpud.org)</u>
- Customer to provide and install electrical (gray) Schedule 40 conduit, 2" for 200-amp service and 3" for 400-amp service
- O Customer to provide and install fiber optic (orange) Schedule 40 conduit in same trench as electrical conduit(1" conduit if less than 100' or 2" conduit if greater than 100')
- Contact Grant PUD for trench and conduit inspections (inspection will occur within 1-2 business days of request)

- Customer to backfill trench if approved or make corrections and contact Grant PUD for another inspection(once corrections have been completed)
