**Statement**

The Priest Rapids Coordinating Committee's Hatchery Sub-committee agrees that:

1. The requirement for evaluation of the Yakama Nation Coho program established in SOA 2007-16 has been met via a PowerPoint presentation by the Yakama Nation to the Priest Rapids Coordinating Committee and the Priest Rapids Coordinating Committee-Hatchery Subcommittee made in July 2017.
2. Future assessments of the Coho program will be based on the project performance indicators/metrics included within Mid-Columbia Coho Restoration Master Plan. The Coho program will be reviewed and updated every two generations (6 years).
3. The Priest Rapids Coordinating Committee-Hatchery Subcommittee will be provided the opportunity to review, comment and provide recommended modifications to the Mid-Columbia Coho Restoration Master Plan during the two-generation review.
4. Reports and presentations that addresses the project performance indicators/metrics included within Mid-Columbia Coho Restoration Master Plan will be provided to the PRCC-Hatchery Subcommittee for review and comment on an annual basis.
