NOTES TO ACCOMPANY TABLE SHOWING CHRONOLOGY OF RATE ADJUSTMENTS

- The District's first general rate increase was in 1971 and followed numerous rate decreases from the inception of District operations on 1941.
- 1) Prior to 2012, irrigation rate adjustments take effect February 1st or March 1st to coincide with season minimum billings, with the exception of the November 1, 1979, June 1, 1990 and March 16, 1992.
- 2) Effective January 1, 1976.
- 3) Formerly Industrial Service Schedule. Large commercial accounts, such as Safeway Stores, were removed from industrial classification and served under the new Large Commercial Rate Schedule effective April 1, 1979.
- 4) Schedule 8, formerly All Electric Processing, made available to all agricultural food processors effective July 15, 1982. The 1982 rate increase equalized Schedule 8 and 9 permitting the transition of food processors from Schedule 9 to Schedule 8. Schedule 8 was closed to new customers effective February 23, 1987. Boiler loads began fuel switching in 1995.
- 5) Rate Schedule 9 was implemented April 1, 1979 to serve large industrial loads that had been receiving service under the former Industrial Rate Schedule 7. A limiting clause was established July 15, 1982, which provides that when energy requirements of the District exceed three billion kilowatt hours, the District will pass on the actual cost of energy and demand acquired for purposes of serving industrial loads in excess of ten average megawatts plus a distribution service charge. Rate Schedule 9B was implemented, effective February 1, 1995.
- 6) Rate Schedule 80 was implemented April 1, 1987 for new agricultural food processing customers. A demand/energy rate form with discounts for service delivered at primary distribution and transmission voltage level was established. The first customers received service under this rate in 1990.
- 7) The 1990 irrigation rate adjustment (first step) took the form of a 10.1 percent surcharge billed in November 1990. A new irrigation rate format (step 2), revenue neutral to GCPUD, was adopted February 4, 1991.
- 8) Rate Schedule 4 - General Water Heating Service and Schedule 5 - Swimming Pool Heating Service were discontinued December 31, 1992. Thereafter, service provided in accordance with Schedule 2 - General Service.
- 9) Rate Schedule 85 - Process Heating and Boiler Service, established by Resolution No. 6630, dated February 8, 1992. No Customers.
- 10) Rate Schedule 1 increase for 2012 was effective on 2/1/2012.
