

CONSTRUCTION FINISHES UP AT CRESCENT BAR

The final touches of the on-island Riverbend Park boat launch and parking area recently wrapped up at the Crescent Bar Recreation Area. Planning for this major overhaul began in 2010 with the work starting in 2014. Finishing this project marked the end of the major construction overhaul at the recreation site.

On June 2, Commissioners Terry Brewer and Tom Flint cut the ceremonial ribbon to open the newly-renovated recreation site during a family-friendly party. Crescent Bar is Grant PUD's most visited location of the 20 recreation sites it operates on or near the Columbia River.

Two final projects, the renovation of the on-island water system and wastewater-treatment plant, will conclude throughout the year. Completion of these projects will put the final stamp on the \$35 million renovation of this popular recreation area. These costs are offset in part by lease payments from more than 400 island homes and condos. The island residents will also reimburse Grant PUD for the bulk of the costs associated with the new water and wastewater systems.
