MEETING MINUTES

Purpose of Meeting – Discussion of Conditional Vote for Nason Ridge Acquisition Proposal:

Request made by B. Rogers for a special meeting of the Habitat SC to discuss and consider a conditional vote on the CCNRD Nason Ridge Acquisition Proposal, Spec Sheet dated February 3, 2021.

- B. Rogers and J. Yeager recently met with Mike Kaputa, Chelan County Natural Resources Department (CCNRD) and Mark Duboiski, Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO).

- The CCNRD and RCO meeting was to discuss the Nason Ridge Acquisition proposal including acreage, funding details, and property protection information.
- Property protection information is included in the RCO Deed of Right and Stewardship Plan.
- Committee members met today to consider a conditional vote today to fund \$750,000 into this project, including details of property protections required.

Additional conditions to the RCO Deed of Right and Stewardship Plan:

- No motorized access.
- No grazing.
- Timber harvest for commercial profit will not be allowed.
- Land management activities.
- Layout of roadways: density, width, adjacent to streams. 2 miles per square mile (or less) (***Chris Fisher will provide back-up doc***) across the whole area.
- Total area protected under these conditions will be equal to the percent of fish funding in the total budget e.g. if the total budget contains 40% fish funding, 40% of the total purchase will be protected under the above conditions.

Path Forward (Action):

D. Rohr, B. Rogers and J. Yeager will put together questions and additional conditions request to present to CCNRD and RCO. Voting consideration will be on-hold until a later date to be determined.
